




# Disruption A29 Haringvliet Bridge and Heinenoord Tunnel in 2023 and 2024



traffic closures traffic diversions

In 2023, Rijkswaterstaat will renovate the Haringvliet Bridge and the Heinenoord Tunnel on the A29. The moving part of the Haringvliet Bridge including the drives will be renewed, and the operating, control and monitoring systems will be replaced. The renovation will be completed by the end of 2023.

Rijkswaterstaat will, among other things, replace all tunnel technical installations of the Heinenoord Tunnel, and a central gallery will be built between the two tunnel tubes. This will form an enclosed escape tunnel. This renovation will start in 2023 and last until the end of 2024.

To ensure safe performance of the renovation work, the bridge and tunnel will be closed several times. Allow for additional journey time on top of the normal journey time.

### Road traffic closure Haringvliet Bridge

- From 9 June to 28 July 2023, with a possible extension to 4 August 2023. In autumn, the bridge will be closed for several nights.

### Road traffic closures Heine Noord Tunnel

- From 28 April to 8 May 2023 in both directions and from 5 August to 1 September 2023. First 3 days in the direction of Bergen op Zoom and from 7 August in both directions.
- In 2023 and 2024, the tunnel will also be closed for a large number of weekends and nights, mostly in 1 direction of travel. In the summer of 2024, the Heine Noord Tunnel will be closed for another two weeks, from 26 July to 12 August. - N59: 7 to 28 August between Hellegatsplein intersection and Den Bommel exit (Schaapsweg).

### Road traffic diversions

- Through traffic from/to Rotterdam to/from Bergen op Zoom: via highways A15, A16, A17 or A59 (and vice versa)
- Local traffic to/from Hoeksche Waard: via the motorway N217 and highway A16 (and vice versa)
- Traffic from/to Rotterdam to/from Goeree-Overflakkee via highways A15, A16, A17 en A59 (and vice versa)
- Traffic from/to Rotterdam to/from Zierikzee: via the highway A15 and motorway N57 (and vice versa)
- Local traffic to/from Goeree Overflakkee: via the motorways N215 and N57 or highways A59, A17 and A16 (and vice versa)

**Allow for additional journey time. The diversion will be indicated by yellow signs and information signs along and above the road.**

### Cyclists and pedestrians

During the closure of the Haringvliet Bridge, cyclists and pedestrians can use a ferry. There's more information at [www.A2roadworks.nl](http://www.A2roadworks.nl).


There will be no inconvenience for cyclists and pedestrians at the Heine Noord Tunnel. They can use the Second Heine Noord Tunnel as they do now. For cyclists and pedestrians, the crossing via the ferries at Oud-Beijerland - Rhoon, Puttershoek - Zwijndrecht and Nieuw-Beijerland - Hekelingen will be free of charge during closures of the Heine Noord Tunnel.

### Closure Haringvliet Bridge for vessels

From 1 January to autumn 2023, vessels with a height exceeding 13 metres will not be able to pass. Vessels with a height exceeding 13 metres will have to take a detour.

### Detour route

Shipping traffic can divert via the North Sea or via the Spui, the Oude Maas and the Dordtsche Kil and should expect much longer sailing times.



### Advice to road users

Rijkswaterstaat will minimise the disruptions. As well as diversions and communications, this includes such measures as adjusting traffic lights to improve traffic flow and campaigns to stimulate cycling and the use of public transport.

You can also take action yourself to minimise disruption:

- be well prepared before departing
- be aware of when roads or waterways are closed and what the diversions are
- check current traffic jams and diversions before you leave via existing apps, [rwsverkeersinfo](http://rwsverkeersinfo) or [vanAaarbeter](http://vanAaarbeter)

And once you are at your destination, please consider:

- renting an e-bike/bicycle for short distance travel
- travelling by public transport
- travelling at other times (outside peak hours)
- avoiding the diversion routes
