

General campsite regulations For alle guests who hire a pitch or accommodation

- On arrival, please report to reception
- Guests and visitors must be notified immediately upon arrival
- Tandem axles / double axles are not allowed
- Your caravan must always be parked so that it does not block the view of your neighbours
- Your car may only be parked on your own pitch. Don't have enough space? Then you can get a parking ticket for the car park at reception.
- The barriers are closed from 10.30 pm to 7.30 am. If you wish to enter or leave the campsite outside these hours, please park your car outside the campsite
- Driving around the campsite at walking pace
- On the day of departure, you are requested to leave the pitch and return the campsite key before 12 noon. Longer stays must be arranged with reception.
- The camping fee includes 4 kWh of electricity. Anything more than this will be charged to you on departure at the current market rate
- Open fires are prohibited on the campsite
- Electric heaters may not be used
- Dispose of waste at the environmental park in the designated containers (household waste, glass and paper; no bulky waste!).
- It is not permitted to wash cars on the campsite
- Please use only air- and light-permeable tent carpets. Rugs damage the turf; guests after you would also like a nice lawn
- Carpet (of any kind) is not permitted in front of the awning
- Tents may not be set up next to the rental accommodation
- Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times
- A maximum of 2 dogs are allowed per pitch
- Dogs are not allowed in the Chalets and Coco Sweets
- Do not leave your pet alone in a hot camp site. If you do, we feel obliged to inform the police and you run the risk of your camping equipment being broken into to free your pet.
- The campsite is not a dog walking area. You are therefore obliged to carry a poop bag with you at all times on the campsite to clean up any accidents immediately. You can walk your dog outside the campsite.
