

Mölke Buggy tour 14 km

Experience the Regge valley +/- 50 minutes

This 14 km route takes you along various points along the Regge such as De Vistrap, Bridge Notter and Zuna, the Meandering of the Regge, the Pelmolen and the foot ferry across the Regge.

- Drive off the vacation park
- Turn **right** onto Molendijk and follow this road
- Go **straight** across the intersection

Here you will find a Schutstal from the 17th century at Erve 't Schot in Notter. Roaming cattle were stabled here. On payment of a fine, the farmer got his livestock back. The oldest form dates from 1690.

- Turn **right** onto the Smeijersdijk.
- Over the bridge turn **right** and park
- After 100m on foot you will find the fish ladder
- Drive back and turn **left** at the T-junction
- Turn **right** onto the dirt road called the verlengde Dennenweg
- Go **straight** across the intersection to the dirt road called Zunaweg
- At the end of the road turn **left** onto the paved road
- Turn **left** at the intersection onto the extended Morsweg
- Go **straight** across the intersection

Look to your right! There you see the beautiful pop-up campsite of the Mölke.

- Next you will see the bridge Notter and Zuna and the Meandering of the Regge
- Cross the bridge
- Turn **right** at the crossroads
- Then take the first road to the **left**
- At the end of the road turn **left** and follow the bend in the road
- Follow the road and cross the railroad
- **After the bend you will find the Diepvrieshuuske**

What is currently located in the Diepvrieshuuske?

- Turn **right** at the end of the road and follow the parallel road

How many farms do you count in the meantime?.....

On the right you will find navigation company Waypoint.

What GPS coordinate does Waypoint have on the building?.....

- Enter the bicycle tunnel and turn **left** in the tunnel
- Turn **left** at the end of the tunnel
- Cross the Wierdensestraat to the Pelmolenweg
- Take the second **left**

Here you will find the Pelmolen on the Regge River

Opening hours:

April - September: tuesday - fri. 10.00 - 17.00.

October - March: Tue. - Fri. 13.00 - 17.00

In 1752 Jan ter Horst, the then mayor of Rijssen, built an oil and flour mill next to the river Regge.

Which boat has a berth at the Pelmolen?.....

- Drive back to the Pelmolenweg and turn **right**
- Cross the Wierdensestraat again
- Go **right** through the tunnel
- Turn **left** at the end of the tunnel
- Take the first bike path onto Molendijk north
- Continue on the industrial area
- Turn **right** before the bridge to the Voetveer
- Park in front of the bridge and turn **right** walking on the bike path
- After 100m on foot you are at the Voetveer

Here you find the Voetveer on the Regge

Which two hamlets does the Voetveer connect?

In the distant past the hamlets of Notter and Zuna were connected by a historic ferry across the Regge. Now the crossing with the hand-operated ferry is a special experience during your walking or biking tour.

- Drive back to the Molendijk and turn **right** to cross the bridge.
- You now drive back to the Mólke and take the first **left** into the park
